Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a systems-based approach to adopting and implementing evidence-based practices in order to improve academic and behavioral outcomes for all students.

PBIS emphasizes the use of data to determine effective behavioral practices and develop a school-wide system, using a continuum of supports ranging from universal to individualized.

PBIS works to improve overall school climate, maximize academic achievement for all students, and address both nonclassroom and classroom management/disciplinary issues, as well as the specific needs of students with severe emotional and behavioral concerns.
